# Geraldton Ticket and Fares Guide

Your ticket can be used for up to 2 hours after the first issue to transfer to other services within the nominated fare zone.

## **50 Cent Student Fare Conditions of use**

The student 50 cent fare is valid for any travel on TransGeraldton services from Monday to Friday from the first to the last gazetted school day of the year, and during mid-year school term holidays and on public holidays that fall on a weekday during the school year.

It is not valid on Saturday and Sunday. Student 50 cent fares are only available when using a Student SmartRider, and cannot be purchased as a cash fare.

## **Free Travel Entitlement Conditions of Use**

WA Seniors, Aged and Disability Support Pension cardholders are entitled to travel for free on all TransGeraldton services between 9.00am and 3.30pm Monday to Friday, all day Saturday and Sundays, as well as public holidays.

The free travel entitlements can only be accessed using SmartRider, so passengers must have a Seniors SmartRider, or Pensioners SmartRider to travel free during these times.
